AN ORDINANCE REVISING AND AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 8 OF DELAWARE TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Delaware Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, consider revision and amendment of certain provisions of Ordinance No. 8 of said Township, enacted December 6, 1966 and effective January 1, 1967, advisable at this time:

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION II, ARTICLE III, TABLE II, which now reads:

"Minimum Capacities for Septic Tanks
(provides for use of garbage grinders, automatic washers and other household appliances.)

No. of Bedrooms	Minimum Tank Capacity
2 or less	750 Gallons
3	900 Gallons
4*	1000 Gallons

*For each additional bedroom, add 250 Gallons.

shall be amended and revised to read as follows:

TABLE II

Minimum Capacities for Septic Tanks
(provides for use of garbage grinders, automatic washers and other household appliances.)

No. of Bedrooms	Minimum Tank Capacity
3 or less	900 Gallons
4*	1000 Gallons

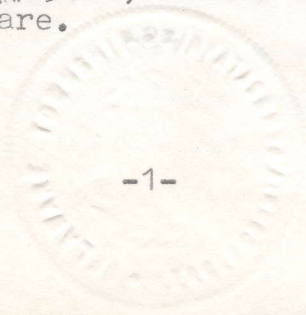
*For each additional bedroom, add 250 Gallons.

SECTION III- Permits, 3.2 which now reads as follows:

"3.2 All applications for permits shall be made to the sanitary officer who shall issue a permit upon compliance by the applicant with provisions of this ordinance and any regulations adopted hereunder and shall be accompanied by a ten (10.00) dollar fee payable to the Township of Delaware."

The Authority shall issue a permit upon compliance by the applicant with the provisions of this Ordinance and any regulations and shall be accompanied by a thirty-five dollar fee payable to the Township of Delaware. Prior to the final inspection of the Sewage disposal facilities an additional twenty-five (\$25.00) fee will be due and payable to the Township of Delaware. That portion of Section III - 2 of Delaware Township Ordinance No. 8A enacted March 5, 1968 which provided for a fee for permits is hereby rescinded.

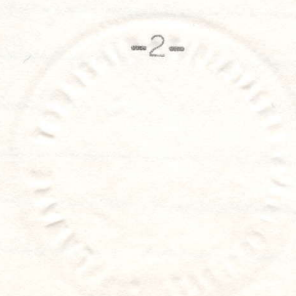

ORDINANCE #8A

An Ordinance of Delaware Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, amending SECTION III of Delaware Township Ordinance No. 8, enacted December 6, 1966, as amended by Ordinance No. 8A, enacted March 5, 1968, is amended to read as follows:

SECTION III

PERMITS

3.2 All applications for permits shall be made to the Sewage Enforcement Officer who shall issue a permit upon compliance by the applicant with provisions of this Ordinance and any regulations adopted hereunder and shall be accompanied by a thirty-five (\$35.00) dollar fee payable to the Township of Delaware. Prior to the final inspection of the Sewage disposal facilities an additional twenty-five (\$25.00) dollar fee will be due and payable to the Township of Delaware. That portion of Section III - 2 of Delaware Township Ordinance No. 8A enacted March 5, 1968 which provided for a fee of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for permits is hereby rescinded.
