

DELAWARE TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE #9

An Ordinance of the Township of Delaware, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, vacating Township Road T-500 from Station 10+50 of the relocation of Township Road T-538 in a generally southeasterly direction for a distance of 520 feet, more or less, to the Shenango River.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD of Supervisors of Delaware Township, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1

That the following Township Road in the Township of Delaware be and is hereby vacated and closed as a public highway of the Township of Delaware. Township Road T-500 from Station 10+50 of the relocation of Township Road T-538 in a generally southeasterly direction for a distance of 520 feet, more or less, to the Shenango River.

SECTION 2

That this Ordinance is passed pursuant to a contract between the United States of America and the Township of Delaware by which the Township of Delaware agreed to vacate and extinguish its public easement in certain roads of the Township of Delaware as part of the development of the reservoir project known as Shenango Reservoir.

SECTION 3

That the Supervisors shall cause the plan or map of the highways or roads of the township to be corrected to show the vacation effected by this ordinance.
