DELAWARE TOWNSHIP MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. 12-95

AN ORDINANCE OF DELAWARE TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PA, SETTING SUPERVISORS

COMPENSATION UNDER PROVISION OF ACT 60 OF 1995.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 60 of 1995, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and WHEREAS, said act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of not more than 4,999 may be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$1,875

per year, and

WHEREAS, the population of Delaware Township is 2064, and WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act 60 authorizes the board of supervisors of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the act,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Delaware Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with

authority of the same as follows:

SECTION ONE: Each supervisor of Delaware Township elected or appointed to office on or after the effective date of the ordinance shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings or hearings of the board of supervisors, or other meeting authorized by the board of supervisors at the rate of \$50 for each meeting attended by such supervisor, not to exceed \$1,875 per year.

SECTION TWO: Such compensation shall be paid yearly.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment.
