A building permit will be issued and the applicant will be notified of the inspection fees and when they can pick-up the permit at the Municipal Building. INSPECTION PROCEDURES MANUFACTURED AND INDUSTRIALIZED HOUSING

- Building permit must be posted on the site of the work and clearly visible from the road until completion of the project.
- Your approved plans must be available at all times, for inspection. These are the plans that were submitted with your application and were marked "Approved" by the building code official.
- The permit applicant is responsible for scheduling all inspections. If you're using a
 General Contractor, then she/he should take care of scheduling all the necessary
 inspections.
- DO NOT schedule an inspection if the work is not ready!!!!
- When scheduling an inspection, you must supply your permit number to the inspector.

1. Footing inspection – To be done after trenching or forming and prior to placing of concrete.
