Ordinance No. 3- 1992C

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE SETTING SPEED LIMITS AND PROCEDURES FOR CHANGING SPEED LIMITS ON TOWNSHIP ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section A. No person or other legal entity shall operate a vehicle over forty-five (45) miles per hour, or such lesser limits as established and posted from time to time under Section B herein, upon roads owned and maintained by the Township. The current speed limit on Willadell and Shearer Roads shall be thirty (30) miles per hour.

Section B. Speed limits less than forty-five (45) miles per hour shall be established after consultation with engineers having knowledge of the safety of traffic traveling upon a roadway and shall be enacted by resolution and posted thirty (30) days in advance of enforcement unless a critical situation occurs which requires that a temporary limit be enacted as required for the safety of the public. Such temporary limits shall not be in force for more than sixty (60) days without further action by the Township Supervisors.

Section D. Penalty. Any person operating an vehicle in excess of the posted speed limits shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine and costs set by the Court under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.
