ORDINANCE NO. O-01-2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DELAWARE TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHANGING THE NAME AND DESIGNATION OF THE TOWNSHIP ROAD NOW KNOWN AS BEIL HILL EXTENSION TO TOWNSHIP ROAD #T542 BEIL HILL AS TO ELIMINATE CONFUSION WITH THE MERCER COUNTY 9-1-1 SYSTEM AND PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIALS AND THE PORTION OF BEIL HILL ROAD HISTORICALLY KNOWN AS SPOOK HILL SHALL NOW BE DESIGNATED AS SPOOK HILL BECOMING TOWNSHIP ROAD #T655.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:


- SECTION 1. **NAME CHANGE:** The Delaware Township Road known Beil Hill Extension shall be hereinafter known as Beil Hill. The portion of Beil Hill Road historically known as Spook Hill shall be hereinafter known as Spook Hill.
- SECTION 2. **REPEALER:** All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED into an Ordinance this 4<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2017, by the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, in lawful session duly assembled.


