

RELEASE OF LIABILITY
*****ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST READ AND SIGN*****

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the ATV riding event sponsored by the Fredonia Volunteer Fire Department as well as any related events and activities and intending to be legally bound, the undersigned:

1. Agrees that, prior to participating, he/she will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if he/she believes anything is unsafe, he/she will immediately advise the Fredonia Volunteer Fire Department of such conditions and refuse to participate.

2. Acknowledges and fully understands that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe economic losses which might result from his/her own actions, inactions or negligence of others, the rules of participation, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, that there may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. Participant understands these risks and further understands that he/she is riding at his/her own risk.

3. Assumes all the foregoing risks and accepts personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or the death.

4. Releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue the Fredonia Volunteer Fire Department, Fredonia Borough, Coolspring Township, Delaware Township, Fairview Township, Otter Creek Township, Jefferson Township, Lake Township, Perry Township and New Vernon Township, their affiliates clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, members, employees, or volunteers of the organization, as well as other participating sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "releasees" from demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

5. Agrees to abide by, acknowledges his/her familiarity with and understands all of the PA State ATV Laws.

6. Agrees to abide by, acknowledges his/her familiarity with and understands all of the Fredonia Volunteer Fire Department's riding event rules which are as follows:
 - a. All riders must have read and signed a Release of Liability form as well as know all of the PA ATV Laws.
 - b. All riders must stay on the trail and follow all trail signs.
 - c. If you need to stop along the trail, pull off only as far as necessary to avoid becoming a hazard (pick a wide spot).
 - d. Follow the 25 MPH speed limit along the entire trail.
 - e. When in town, stay on ATV-designed roads and follow all traffic laws.
 - f. Follow the flow of traffic and stay to the right, most of the trail is one way.
 - g. All ATVs must meet or exceed PA State Laws and hold valid registration and liability insurance for their state.

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- h. In addition, to any safety equipment required by PA State Laws, riders are required to wear a helmet, goggles or shield and boots.
- i. Failure to follow these rules could lead to removal from the riding event without refund.

7. Agrees to ride in a safe and appropriate manner at all times.
